Alexanders *Smyrnium olusatrum* Big and bushy, common on roadsides



Pennywort *Umbilicus rupestris* Common in hedgerows



Blackthorn (Sloe) *Prunus spinosa* Flowers before Mayflower (Hawthorn)



English Bluebell Hyacinthoides non-scripta Also Spanish varieties (more upright) and hybrids. Sometimes white



Wood Sorrell *Oxalis acetosella* Very attractive small flowers



Red Valerian *Centranthus ruber* Common along roadsides/hedges



Ivy leaved toadflax Cymbalaria muralis Common on walls/ kerbsides



Lady's Smock *Cardamine pratensis* Found in a few grassy places



Cuckoo-pint *Arum maculatum* Common in shady places



Red Campion *Silene dioica* Common in hedgerows
